

## **Information on SIMB participation schedule and guidelines**

### **1. Information on participation in the finals**

There is no place to change clothes. Please participate in comfortable performance clothing.

Overseas participants will be provided with an accompanist. However, in order to use an accompanist, you must provide sheet music and song title in advance.

After rechecking the participant's final song sent to you by email, if there is a mistake or you wish to change it, please make corrections by replying to the email.

If you submit a song that cannot be performed with an orchestra, it may be changed to a solo performance instead of an orchestra performance depending on the situation.

If you would like to change the orchestral piece you submitted, please send us an email with the title of the piece you are changing.

The main competition begins at 10 a.m. on June 6.

The order of the contest will be determined through a drawing at 9 a.m. All participants must arrive before 9:00 am.

Visitors other than participants can watch from the second floor of the competition hall.

We will announce the winners immediately after the contest ends.

However, the winners' ceremony and award ceremony will be held at the Park Concert on June 8th.

After the contest ends, the finalists will participate in mentoring classes, lecture concerts, etc. from the afternoon of the 6th. (See detailed schedule)

On the afternoon of the 7th, we will watch the Legend Professor's Concert. It is a paid seated performance, but all finalists can attend for free.

### **3. Transportation vouchers provided**

Participants in the final round will be provided with one top-up transportation card.

50,000 won (KRW) is loaded on the transportation card.
